

PACIFIC STATES UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

INSTRUCTION

Please answer all questions legibly and completely so that your application will be processed and evaluated in a timely manner. Please attach an essay answering each of the essay topic of the category which you are applying for. It is preferred (but not strictly required) that you also include a letter of recommendation from a PSU faculty member. Incomplete application will not be accepted.

Students may apply for scholarships for the Spring & Fall Quarters for Tuition Credit only.

General Eligibility

Student must meet these general eligibility criteria:

- a) be enrolled full-time in the current quarter;
- b) show no outstanding balances up to previous quarter, made 1/3 tuition payment for the current quarter, and clear the balance of the current quarter by the end of the quarter:
- submit a well-written essay in 12-point Times New Romans font,
 page margin, and at least 1 page in length;
- d) be present at the award ceremony (or send a person on your behalf); and
- e) additional criteria of each scholarship category.

Application Procedure

Students must submit full application to Office of Student Services during the first week of the Spring Quarter or Fall Quarter. Completed applications will be reviewed by the PSU Scholarship Committee. Nominees are presented to the President for final approval. Awards will be made near the end of the third week of the quarter with adjustments made to the student'

Criteria for Scholarship Awards

The Scholarship Committee will consider the student's a) meeting the criteria of the scholarship category; and b) personal essay. (Reused essay will be considered sufficient cause to cancel application)

Amounts of Scholarships

Multiple scholarships may be awarded per category; the value will range between \$100 to \$2,000. These scholarships are funded through the University's General Fund and generosity of independent donors, PSU alumni and the campus community.

Restrictions

Students may apply for a maximum of three scholarships semi-annually. Students may receive a maximum of three scholarships annually. For graduate level students, the maximum number of scholarship awarded is four; for undergraduate level students, the maximum number of scholarship awarded is eight. Accounting Certificate program students are ineligible for scholarship.
